Administrative lawsuit – The General Court turns to the Constitutional Court

Graphisoft Park SE hereby informs its Shareholders and the capital market participants that, in the administrative lawsuit filed against the decision abolishing the deadline for indemnification, the **Budapest-Capital Regional Court has granted Graphisoft Park's motion: the Court will refer the matter to the Constitutional Court, seeking a ruling that the statutory provision forming the legal basis of the decision is unconstitutional and requesting its annulment.**

The Company has previously informed its Shareholders about the status of the remediation case, which has been ongoing for decades (see: [Remediation – A new intervention plan to be prepared by December 31, 2026](#), [Initiation of Judicial Review Procedure - Remediation](#), [Conclusion of administrative lawsuit](#), [Initiation of administrative lawsuit](#)). In its current decision, the Court agreed in substance that the rule of law was not upheld during the postponement of the remediation, which was made possible by legislation.

According to the Constitution, the Constitutional Court may issue a decision within 90 days; the administrative lawsuit will continue following the Constitutional Court's decision.

The expected start and completion dates for the remediation remain uncertain and cannot yet be estimated.
