

Investor presentation on GRÁNIT Bank Plc. 2026.1-3. month results

(based on unaudited separate and consolidated figures)

Gránit Bank closed the first quarter of 2026 with its highest-ever pre-tax and after-tax profits, dynamic growth, excellent cost efficiency and portfolio quality, as well as cutting-edge innovations

✓ Highest quarterly after-tax profit to date

- In Q1 2026, the Bank reported an accounting net income of HUF 6.6 billion, which is 41% higher than in Q4 2025. Profit before tax was HUF 6.9 billion, representing a 29% increase compared to the previous quarter's performance. After adjusting for dividends received and lump-sum special taxes, first-quarter net income was 3.5% higher than in the previous three months.

✓ Dynamic business growth / Growing market share

- The Bank's outstanding loan and bond portfolio grew by 4.4% in Q1 2026, compared with a 2.5% increase in the market. Deposits grew by 12.0% during the quarter, compared with an 8.6% increase in the market.
- Gránit Bank's market share rose to 2.2% in total assets, 3.5% in deposits, and 2.3% in loans by the end of March 2026.
- In Q1 2026, there were 30% more new accounts opened in the Retail segment and 27% more in the Corporate segment compared to the first quarter of the previous year.

✓ Excellent asset quality

- The non-performing loan (NPL) ratio stood at 0.4% at the end of Q1 2026, compared with a market average of 2.1% (as of the end of 2025).

✓ Excellent cost efficiency

- The Bank continues to have a significant cost-efficiency advantage: while the banking sector's operating expense-to-total assets ratio stands at 1.8%, Gránit Bank's ratio is 1.0%. Adjusted for dividends received and lump-sum special taxes, the operating expense-to-revenue ratio (CIR%) of 40.4% is 49.3 pp better than the market average (89.7%).

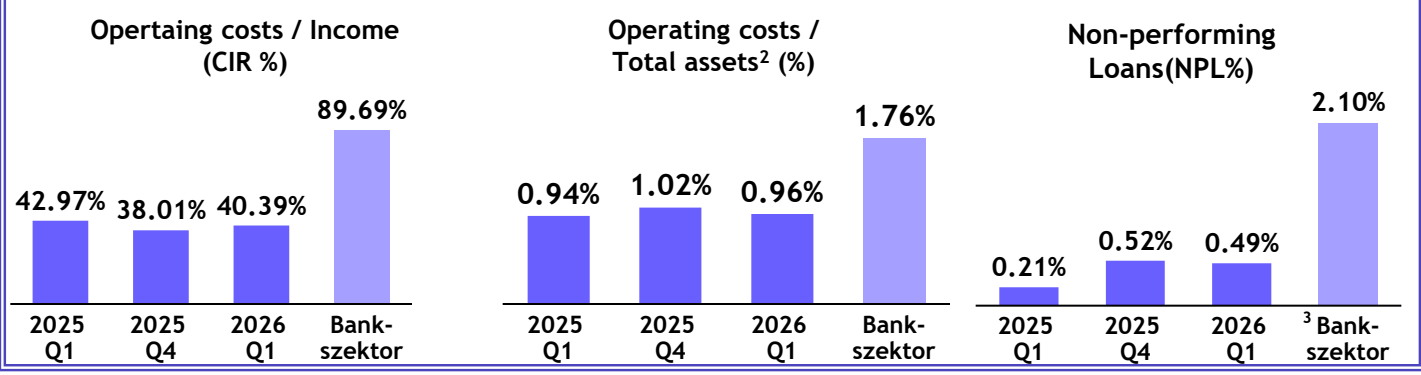
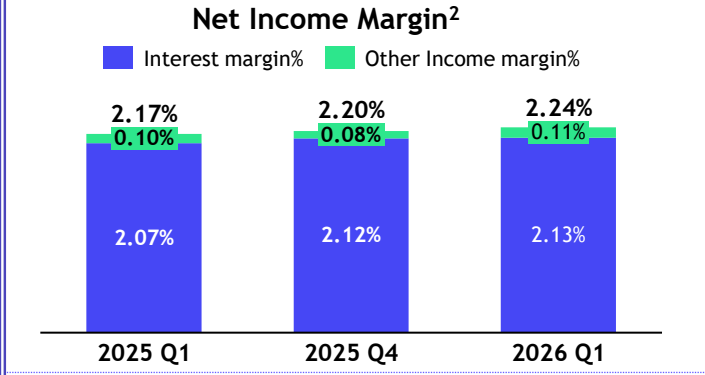
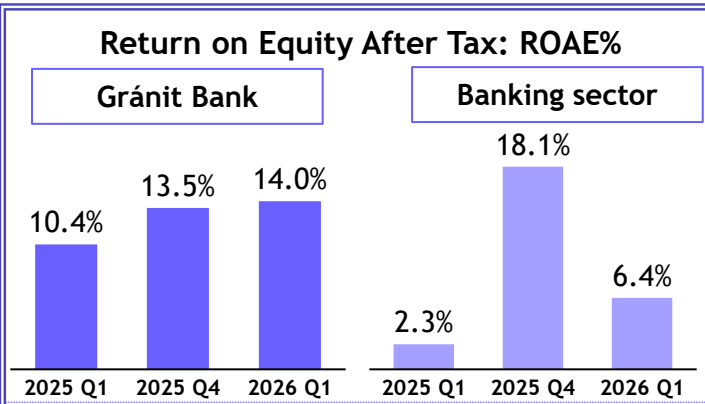
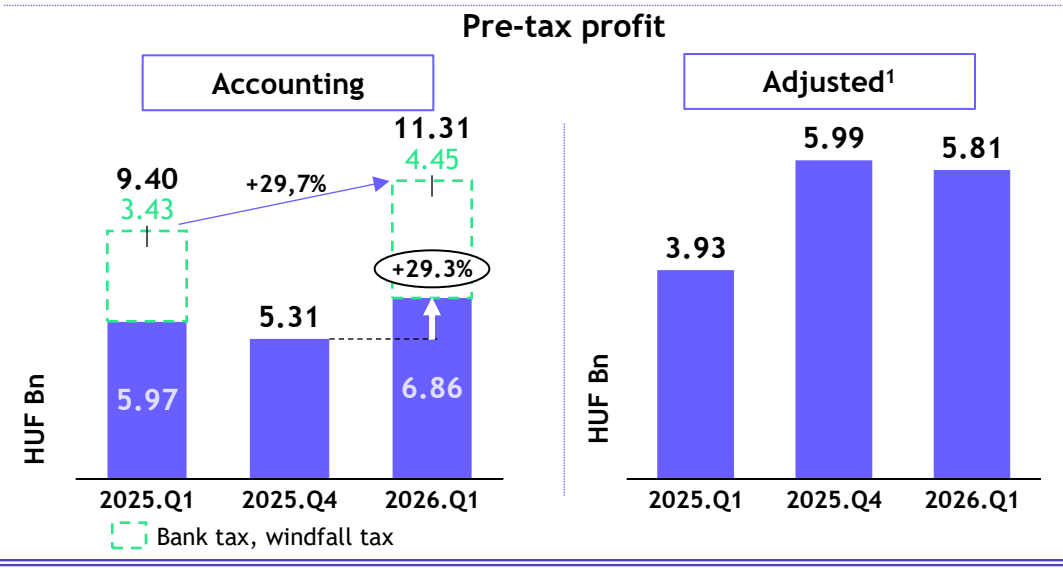
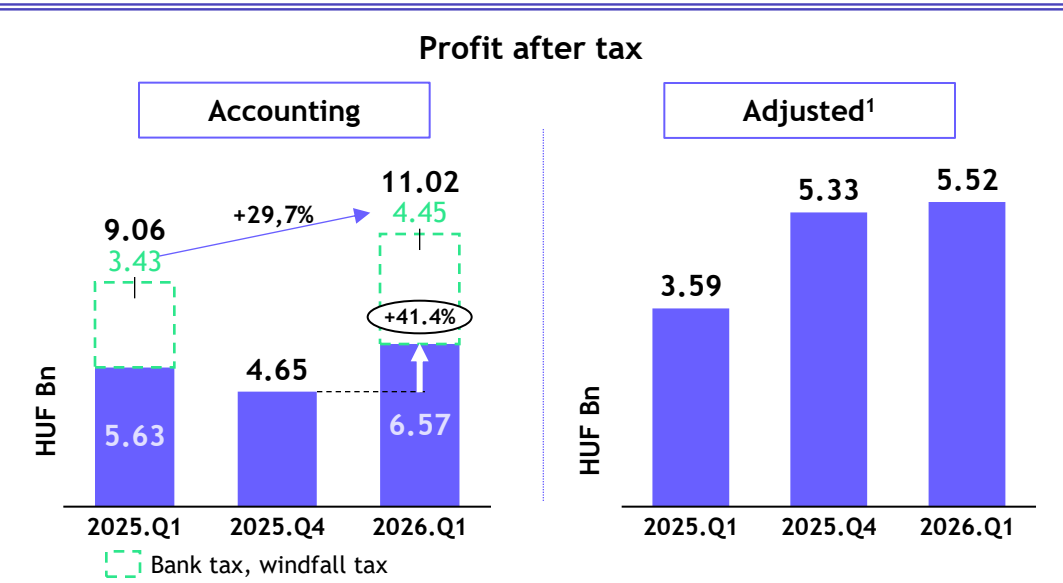
✓ Leading innovations / Expanding product range

- The Piggy Bank savings option is available in the app for both Hungarian and Romanian customers.
- Single-use bank cards are also available for Romanian customer.
- Fairpay: Starting in 2026, bank card acceptance became available in VPOS/SoftPOS environments as well.
- The Bank significantly revamped the self-service account opening process, making it possible to open an account in the Gránit app in as little as 1.5-2 minutes.
- In Q1 2026, the Bank released 5 new versions of the mobile banking app, partly to introduce new products (Persely savings option in the app for both Hungarian and Romanian customers, single-use cards in the app for Romanian customers as well, card acceptance in Fairpay, continuous expansion of Gránit Guru's capabilities), and partly to enhance the customer experience.
- Opening a health savings account is expected to become available in the app in Q3 2026.
- In Q3 2026, the range of investment services will expand to include European stocks and EUR-denominated ETFs, with U.S. stocks becoming available in Q4.

✓ Solid capital position and liquidity

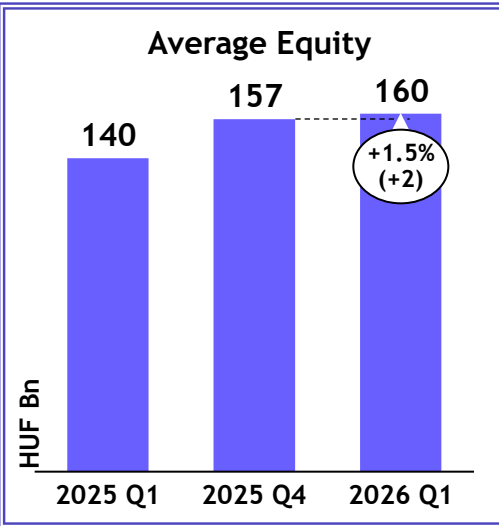
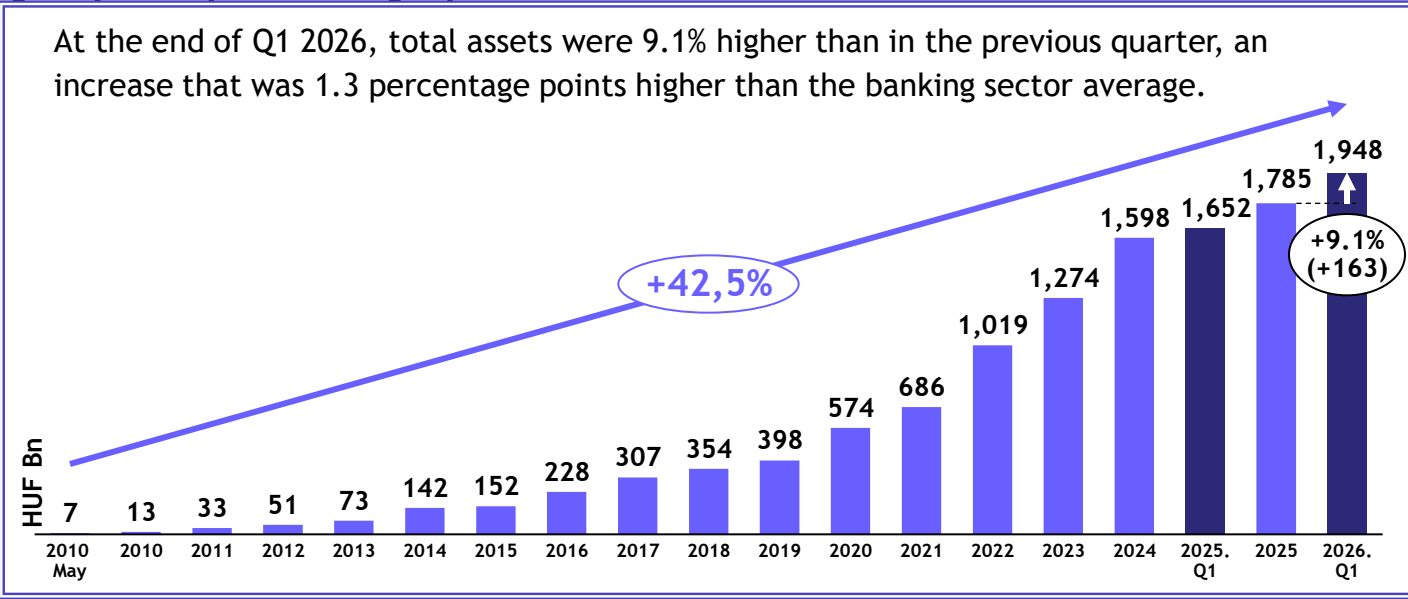
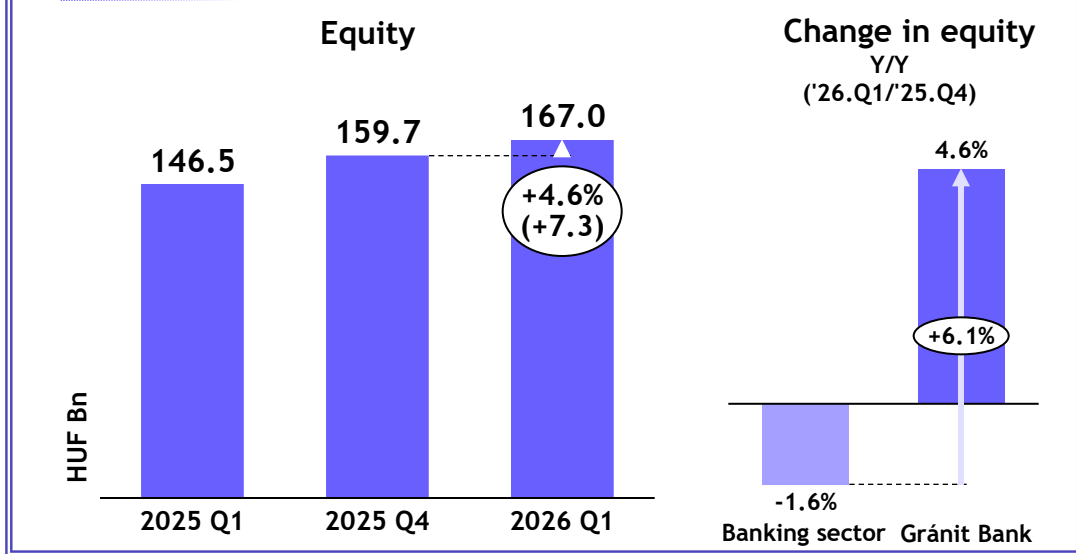
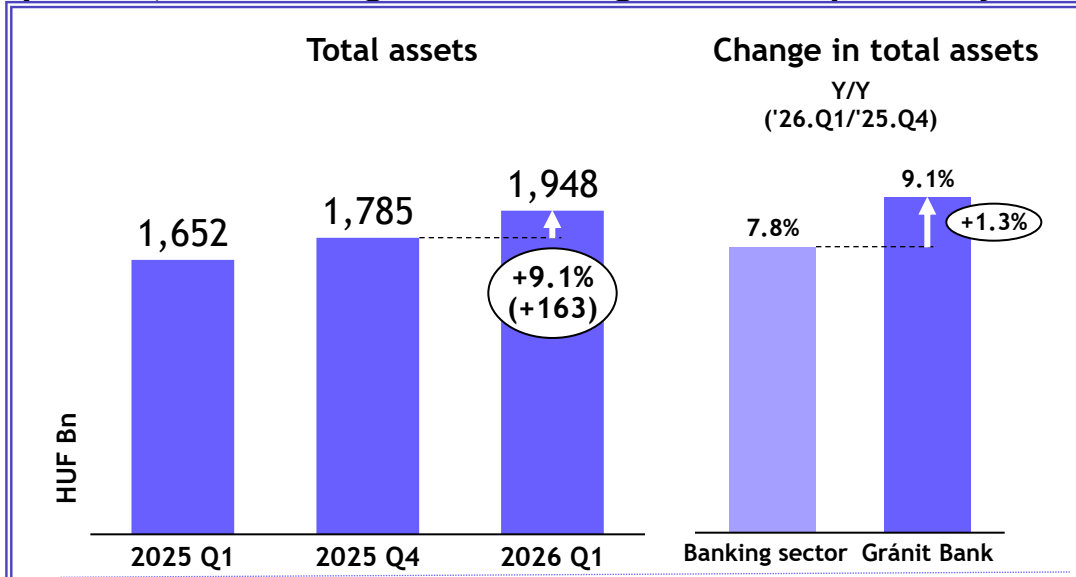
- Both the standalone T1 capital adequacy ratio and the total capital adequacy ratio stood at 21.3% at the end of the first quarter, which is 4.35 percentage points higher than regulatory requirements. The net loan-to-deposit ratio is 56.6%, which is significantly lower than the market average (85.8%).
- The standalone liquidity coverage ratio (LCR%) was 162.0% at the end of the first quarter of 2026, and the net stable funding ratio (NSFR%) was 158.8%.

On an standalone basis, **Gránit Bank** reported an **after-tax accounting profit** of 6.6 billion HUF in Q1 2026, despite the fact that the bank tax and extra-profit tax, recognized as a lump sum, were 29.7% higher.



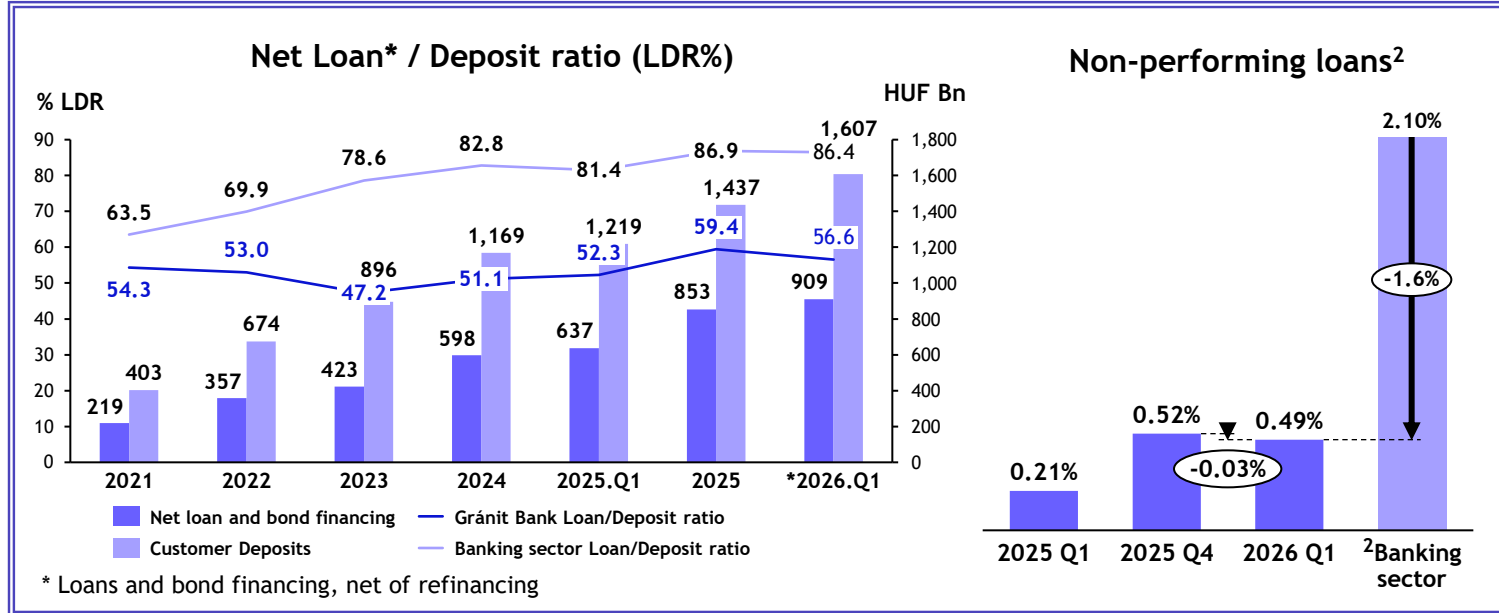
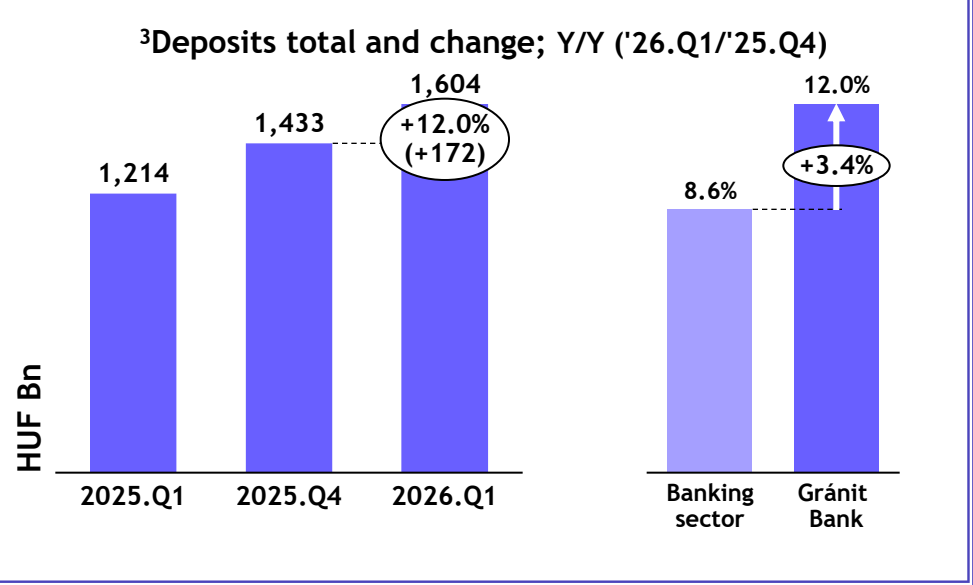
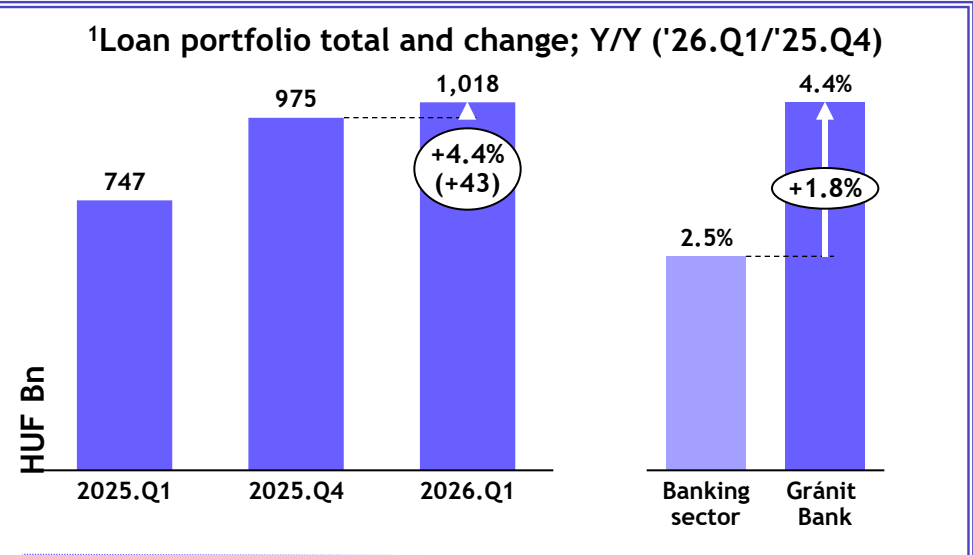
- Return on equity after tax was 14.0%, which is 0.6 percentage points higher than the previous quarter's figure due to the increase in quarterly earnings. The banking sector's return on equity after tax for the first quarter was 6.4%, which is significantly lower than the previous quarter's result.
- The net interest margin is higher than in both the previous quarter and the same quarter a year ago, driven by higher commission margins (net commission income after transaction fees) and interest margins.
- The operating expense-to-revenue ratio and the operating expense-to-total assets ratio were also significantly better than the banking sector average at the end of the first quarter of this year.

The growth in total assets and equity exceeds the banking sector average. **Gránit Bank's total assets** amount to HUF 1.948 billion, representing a 9.1% increase compared to the previous quarter, while equity rose by 4.6% over the course of a quarter, exceeding the banking sector's quarterly change by 6.1 percentage points.

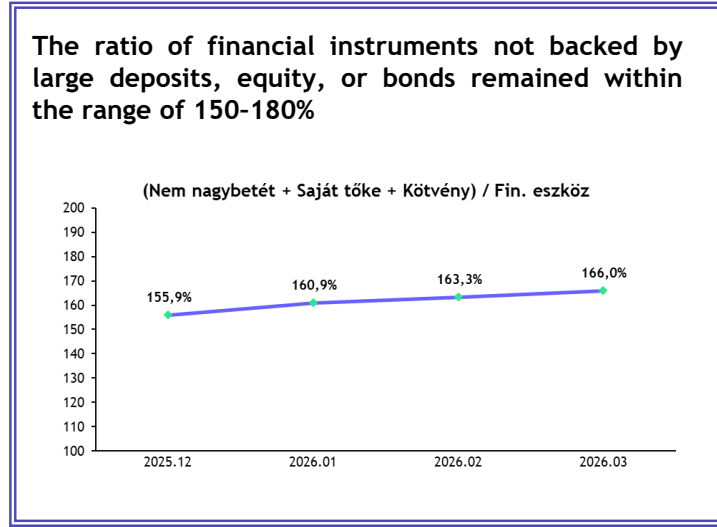


- Total assets grew by 9.1% in the past quarter (Q1 2026/Q4 2025), exceeding the market average growth rate of 7.8%. This growth
 - was driven by a 12.0% increase in customer deposits (shown on the next page) (+HUF 172 billion) and
 - a 4.6% annual increase in equity (retained earnings), compared to a 1.6% decline in the banking sector.
- The quarterly average of equity increased by 1.5% during the last quarter.
- The change in equity at the end of the quarter exceeded the market's 1.6% decline by 6.1 percentage points.

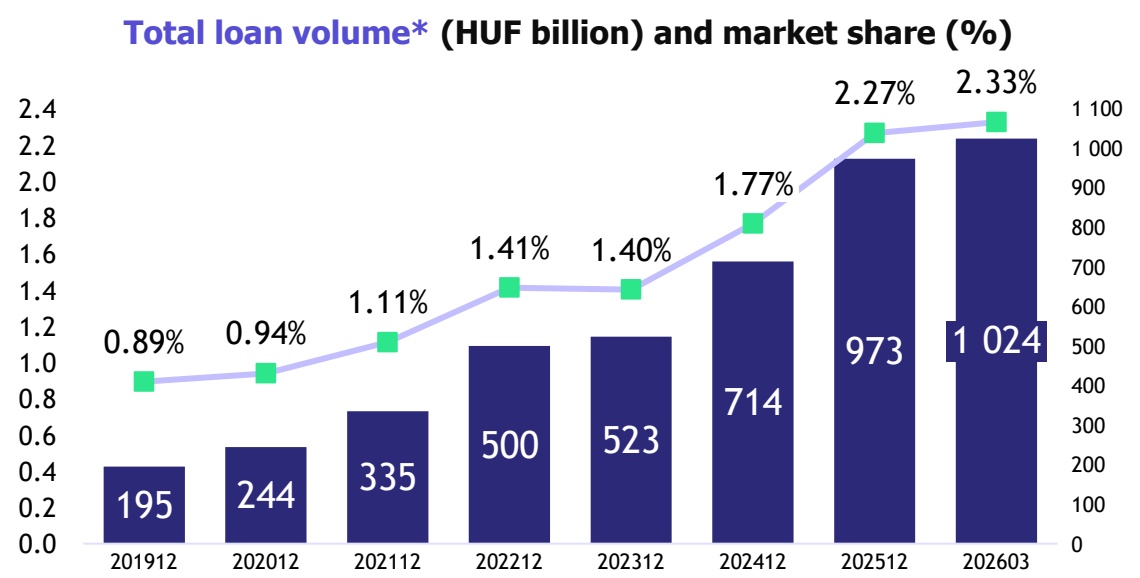
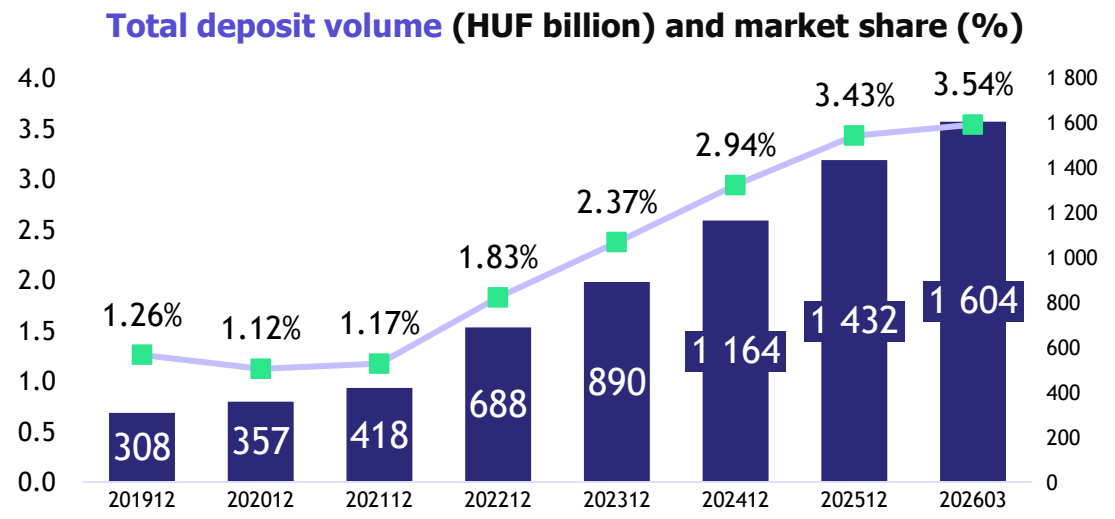
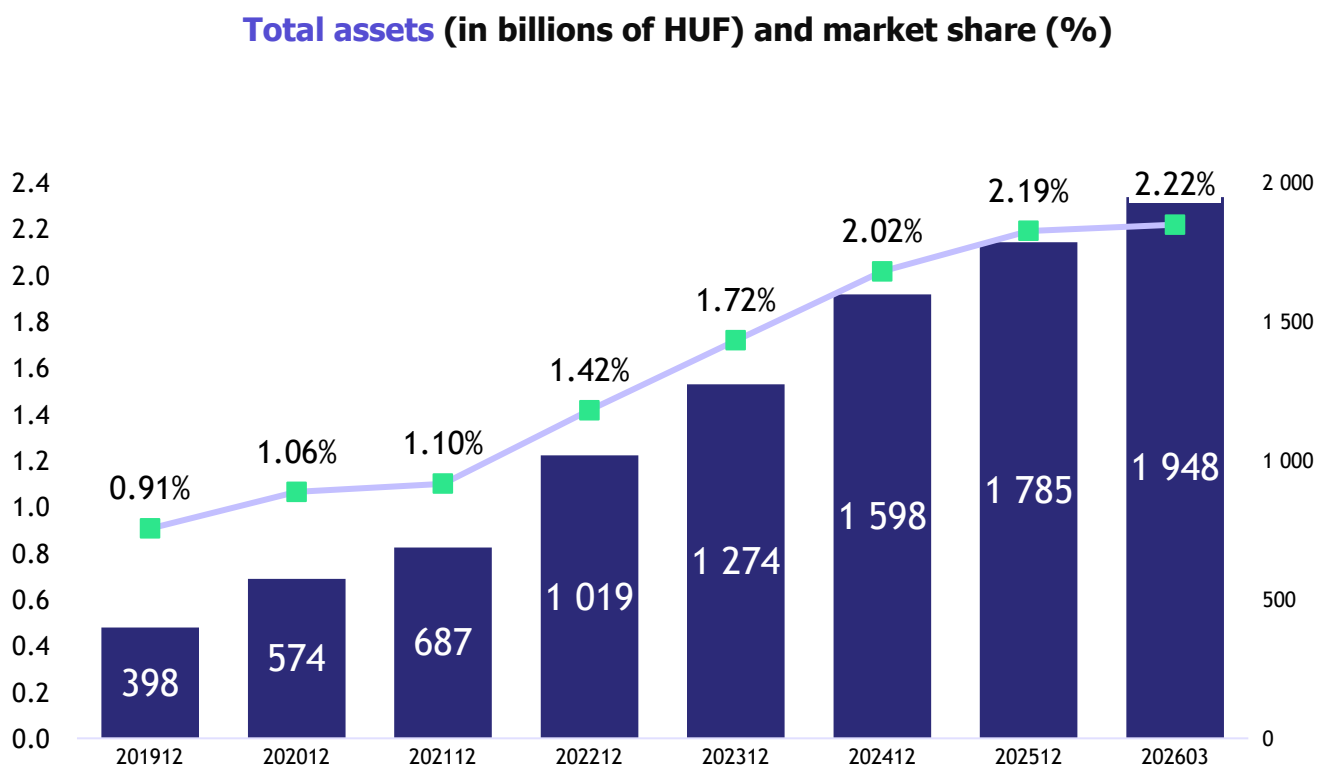
In the past quarter, **Gránit Bank** increased its loan portfolio by 4.4% and its deposits by 12.0%, with the growth rates for both indicators significantly above the banking sector average.



- **The loan portfolio** (comprising corporate, retail, and institutional financing) grew by 36.3% over the course of a year, while the market expanded by 9.9%.
- **Customer deposits** increased by 32.1% over 12 months, compared with an 11.8% rise in the market.
- **Loan growth** was financed by increases in deposits, refinancing, and equity. In line with the bank's business activity, the net loan-to-deposit ratio rose by 4.3 percentage points to 56.6% over the course of a year, which is 28.8 percentage points lower than the banking sector average.
- **The non-performing loan ratio** stands at 0.49% (0.03 percentage points lower than at the end of the previous quarter). The cost of risk is -0.03%.

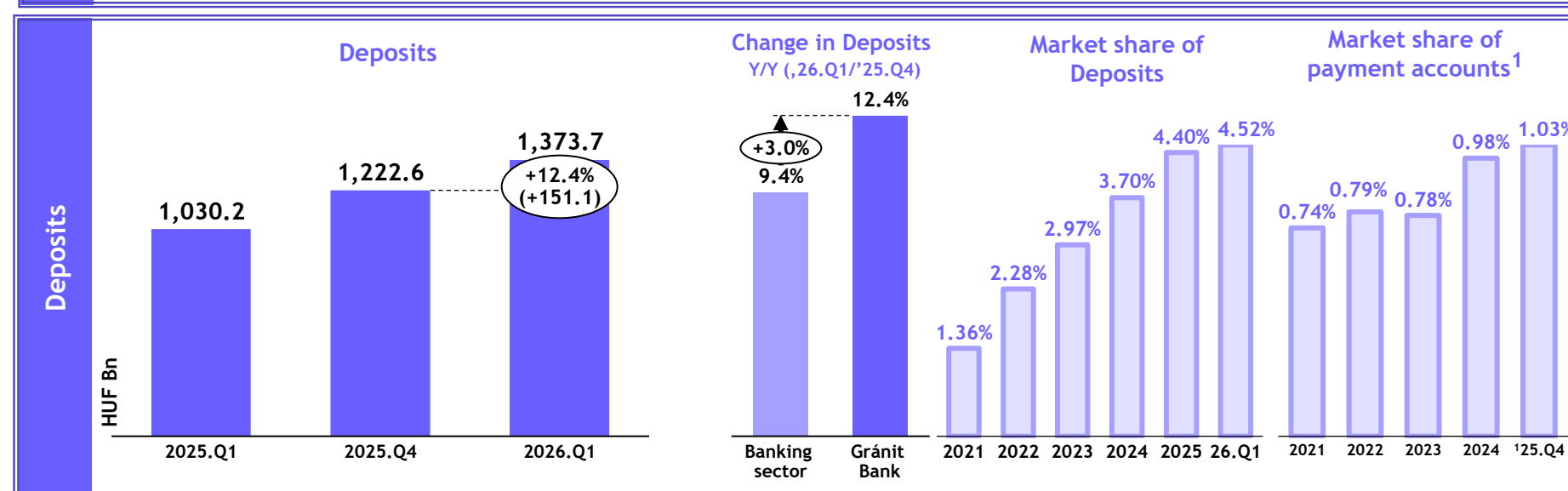
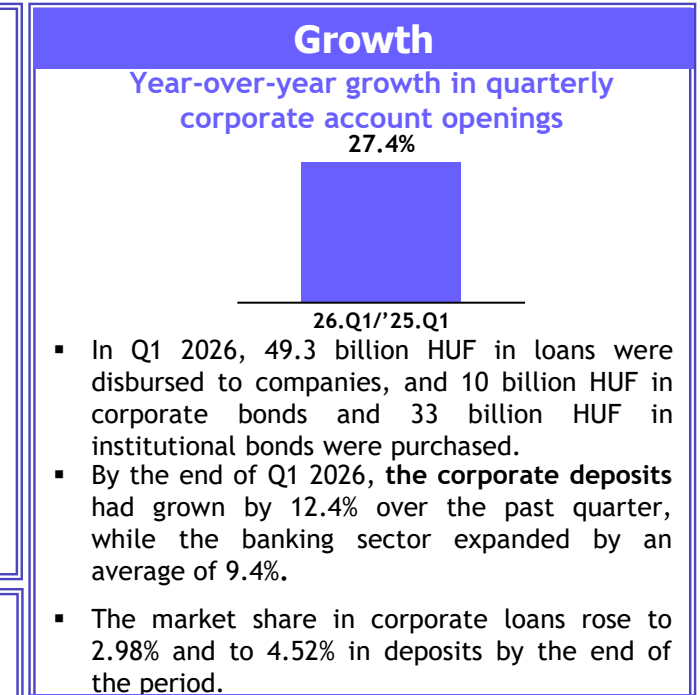
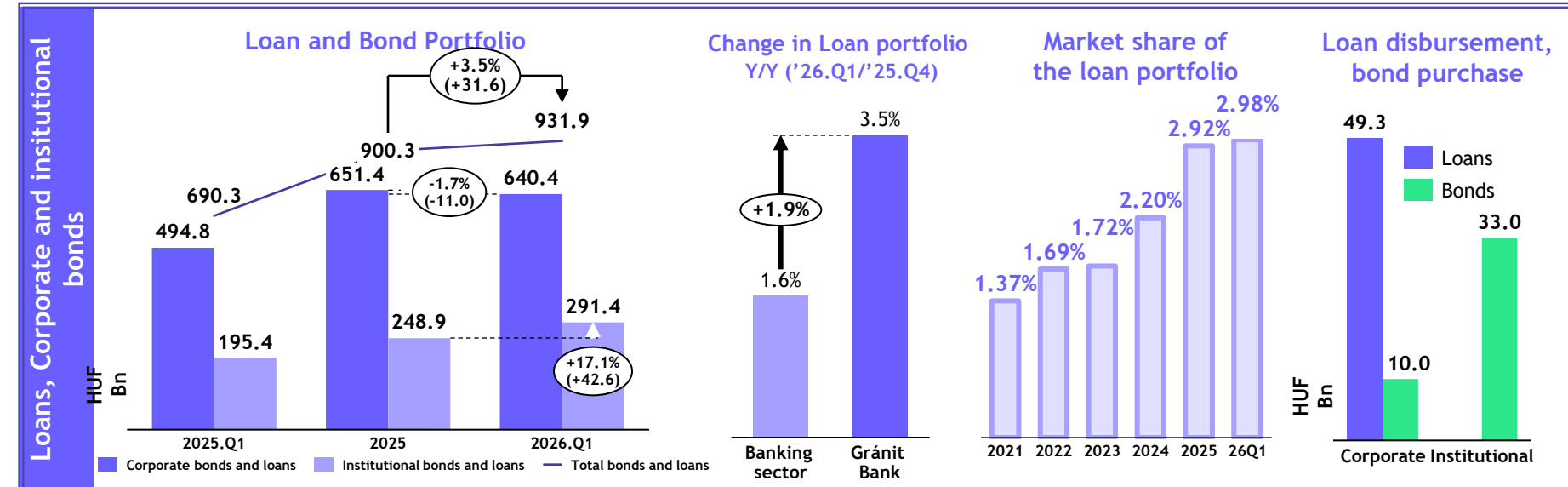


By the end of March 2026, **Gránit Bank's** market share had risen to 2.22% of total assets, 3.54% of total deposits, and 2.33% of total loans.

The volume of **loans to companies** and institutions grew by 3.5% in the first quarter of this year. The volume of **deposits** rose by 12.4% since the end of last year, closing out the first quarter.



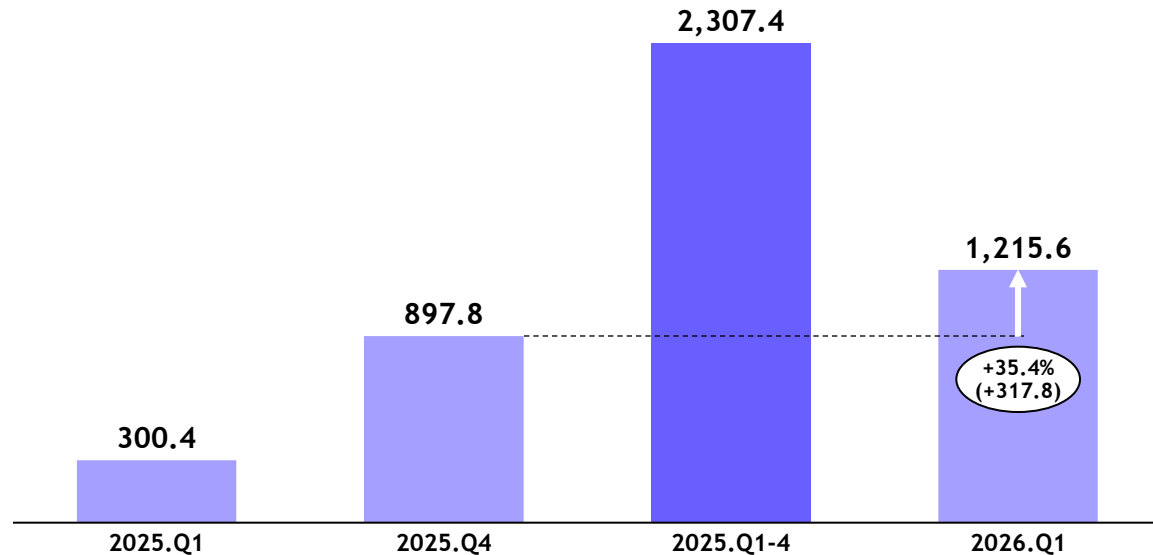
Innovation and Development

- Gránit Bank is providing the fairpay service as a sub-aggregator starting in the second quarter of 2025: it is the first in the market to enable the fast and efficient bulk generation of up to several million unique qvik QR codes or qvik payment links for invoices, fee requests, or other payment notices.
- The fairpay system is currently used by 6 universities, with a total of more than 3,5 billion HUF in transactions processed.
- The process for opening an account via the video bank has been further improved.

Gránit Bank's FairPay payment platform is now used by four institutions, six universities, and 70 thousand students. Compared to the previous quarter, transaction volume increased by 35.4%, and it has quadrupled over the past year.

In October 2023, Gránit Bank launched FairPay, a unique electronic payment solution based on payment requests, which it made available to higher education institutions in Hungary by integrating it into the Neptun system.

Currently, 70 thousand students at 6 universities actively use it to pay for study-related expenses.

In the first quarter of 2026, the Hungarian Economic Association also launched the FairPay service.

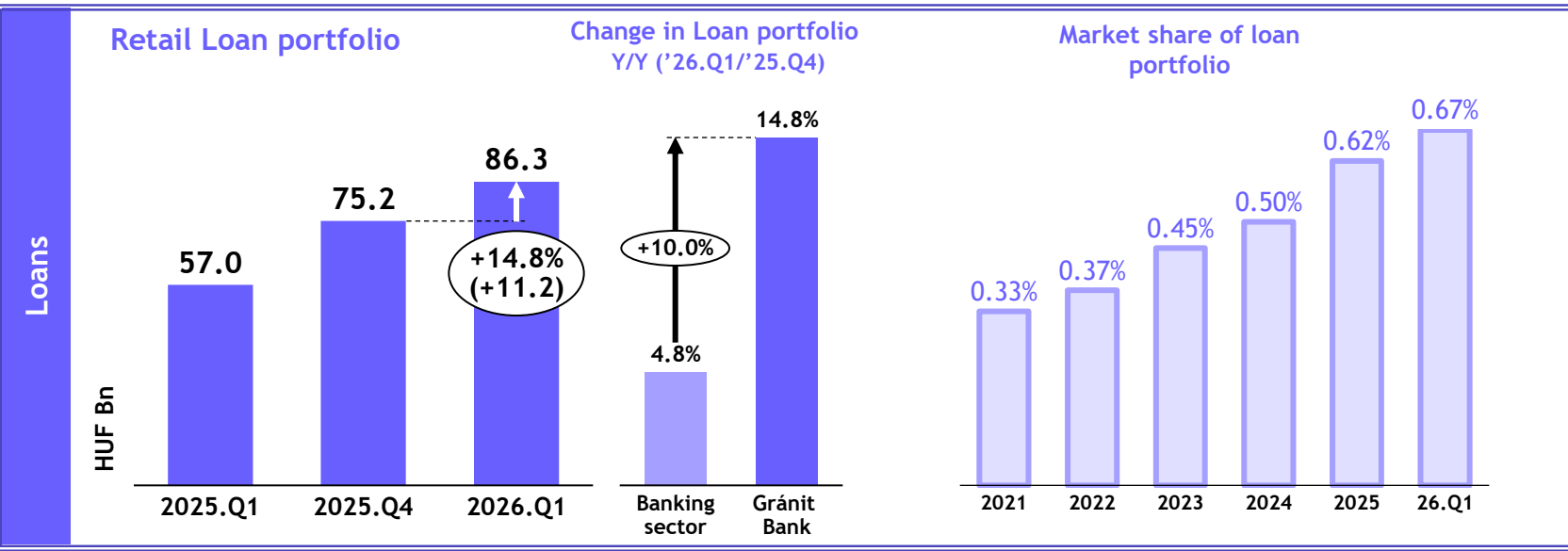
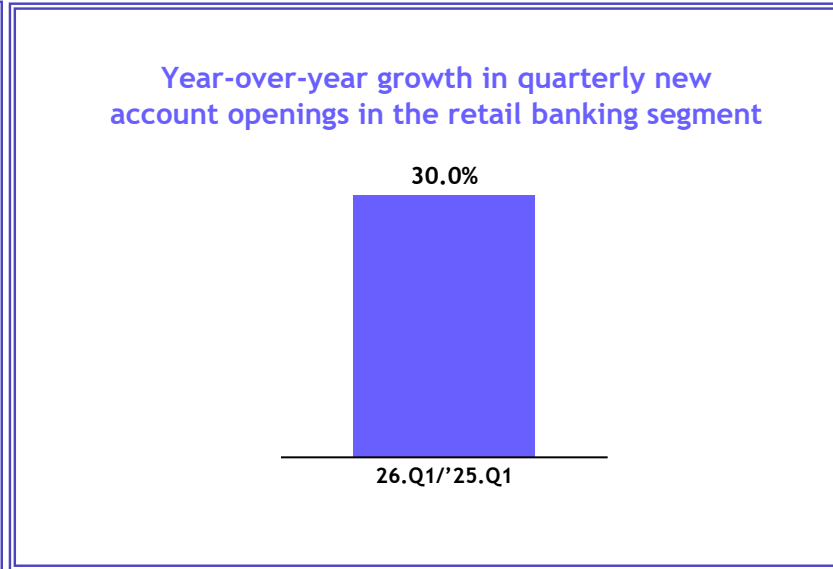
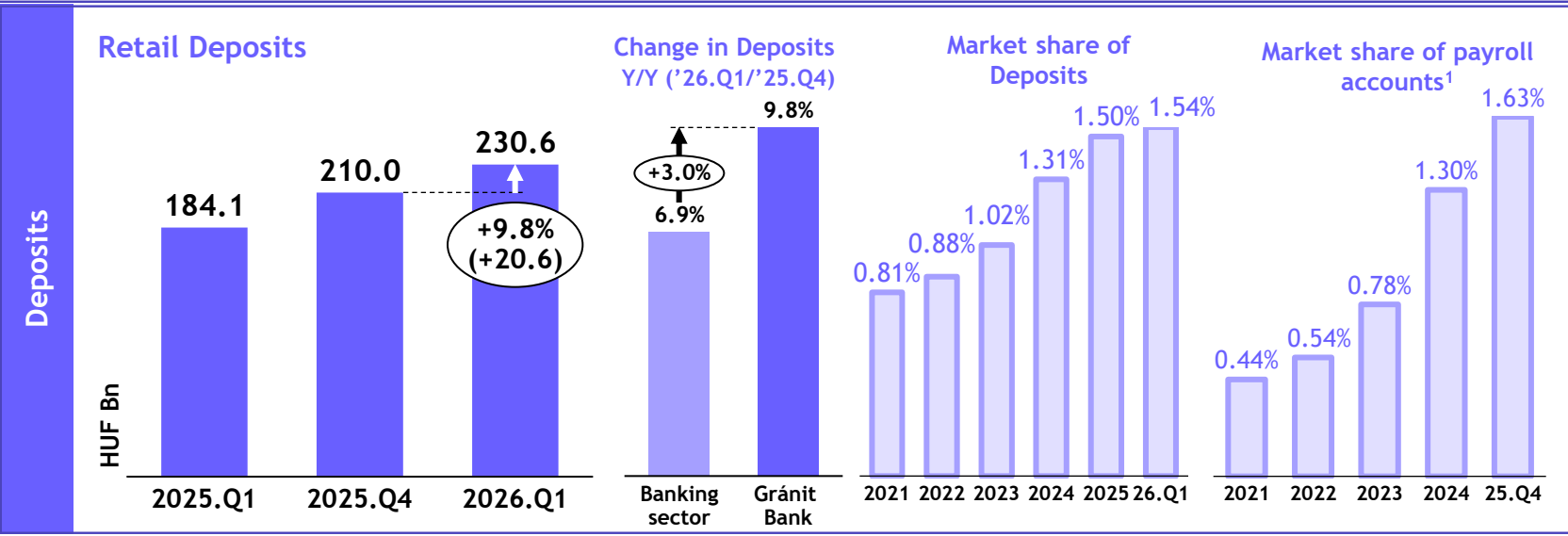
FairPay is Gránit Bank's comprehensive payment solution, which enables both bank card and qvik acceptance within a single system. It is easy to integrate and supports online, in-person, and mobile payment scenarios. Among Hungarian banks, Gránit Bank is the first—and currently the only one—to offer contactless qvik payments at physical terminals (POS), as well as qvik-based payment solutions (qvik-QR, qvik-link) tailored for bulk billing processes.

Gránit Bank is continuously developing FairPay to provide a unified, comprehensive payment platform that offers solutions for any payment scenario, from qvik payments to credit card purchases.

By the end of 2025, FairPay had become a universal payment platform covering all payment channels—online, mobile, and in-person.

Starting in 2026, in addition to qvik, bank card acceptance became available in VPOS/SoftPOS environments as well.

In both the retail deposits and loans segments, Gránit Bank grew at a rate significantly above the market average in the past quarter.



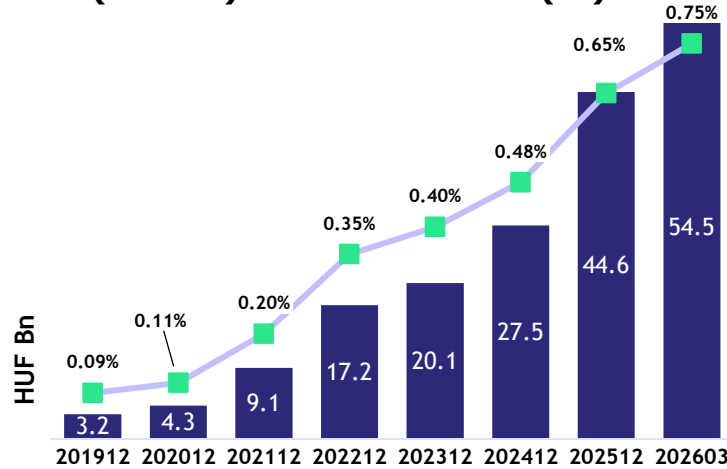
- In the retail banking segment, the deposits grew by 9.8 percentage points in the previous quarter, which is nearly 1.5 times the banking sector's 6.9% growth.
- In 2025, one in six of all net new payment accounts was opened at Gránit Bank. Market data for the first quarter of 2026 will be released in June.
- Customers opened a total of 13,100 accounts in the Romanian market.
- In 2026, the bank will enter the Spanish market by expanding its cross-border services.
- In the lending business, the loan portfolio grew by 51.3% compared to the first quarter of the previous year. In the last quarter, it grew by 14.8%, compared to the market's 4.8% growth. The portfolio grew primarily due to the huge interest in Otthon Start loans and the resulting disbursements.

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Over the past year, Gránit Bank has further increased its market share in retail lending.

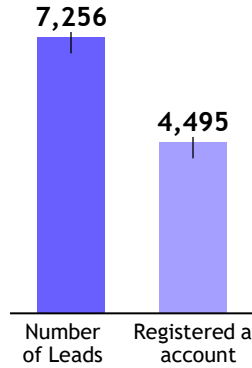
Mortgage loans

Portfolio of residential mortgage loans (HUF Bn) and market share (%)



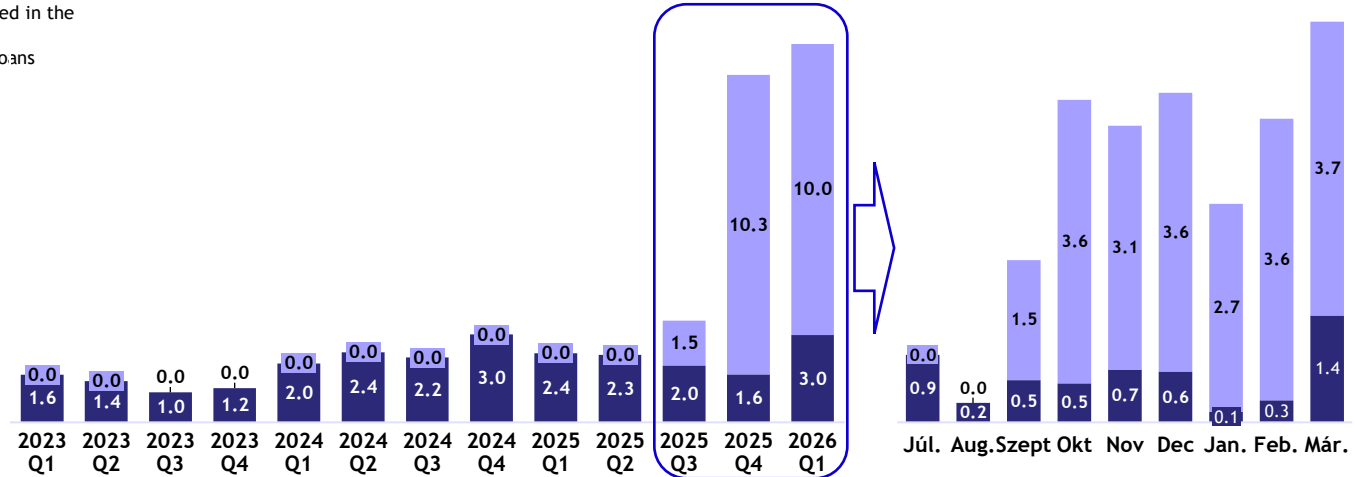

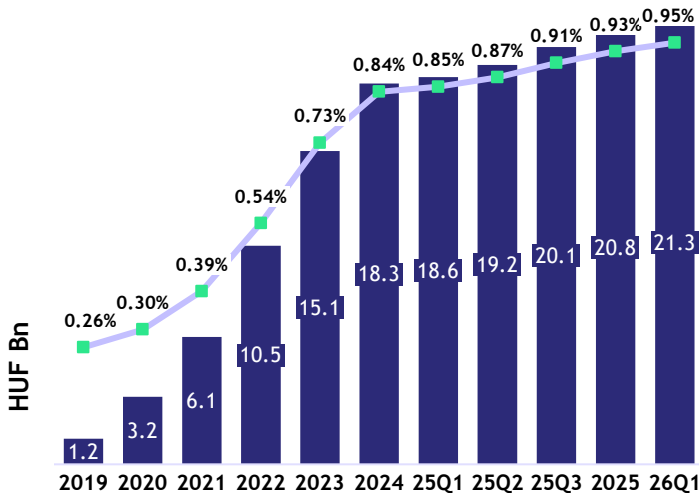
Mortgage loan approvals by quarter and month (HUF Bn)

■ Mortgage loan (non-OSP) ■ Otthon Start (OSP)

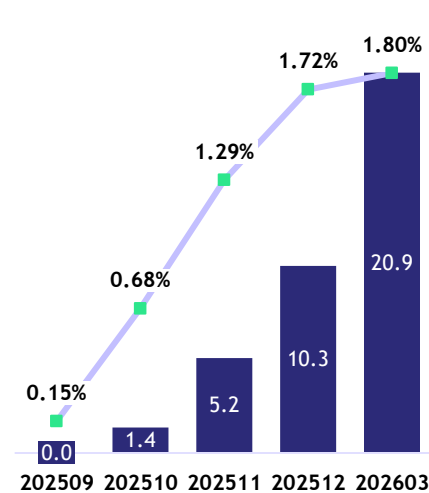

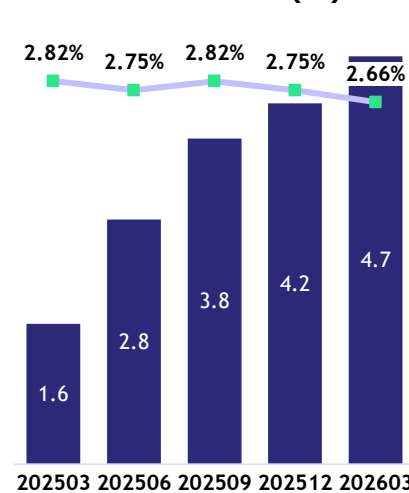
Portfolio of baby-expectant loans (HUF Bn) and market share (%)



Otthon Start loan volume (HUF Bn) and market share (%)



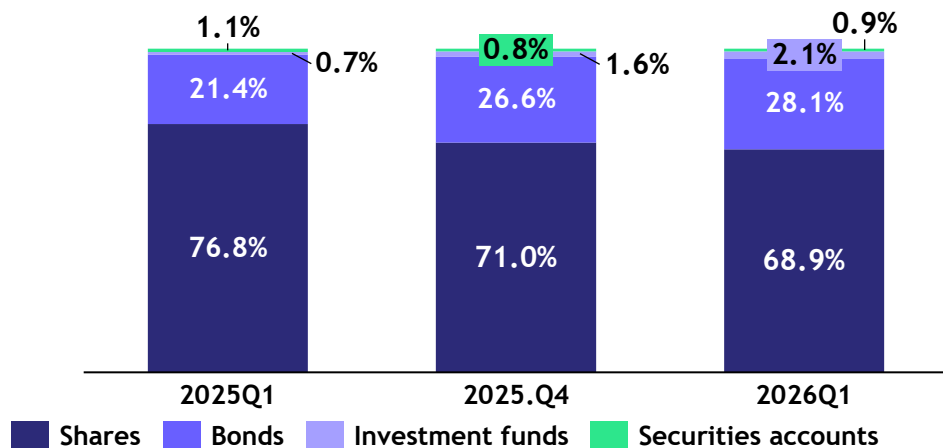
Worker loans volume (HUF Bn) and market share (%)



- In the retail segment, in addition to standard mortgage loans, overdrafts, and credit cards, government-subsidized loan programs are also available (Baby Loan, CSOK, CSOK Plus, Worker Loan, and Otthon Start Home Loan).
- In the first quarter of this year, interest in Otthon Start loans remained extremely high: by the end of Q1 2026, 512 loans had been approved with an average principal amount of HUF 46 million. Based on transactions completed by year-end, the Bank's market share stood at 1.8%.
- The Bank's market share in baby-expectant loans has risen steadily, with the portfolio growing to HUF 21 billion by the end of Q1 2026.
- The Bank's market share in Worker loans grew through the end of the third quarter of last year, approaching 3%; since then, sales have lost momentum due to the surge in interest in the Otthon Start program.

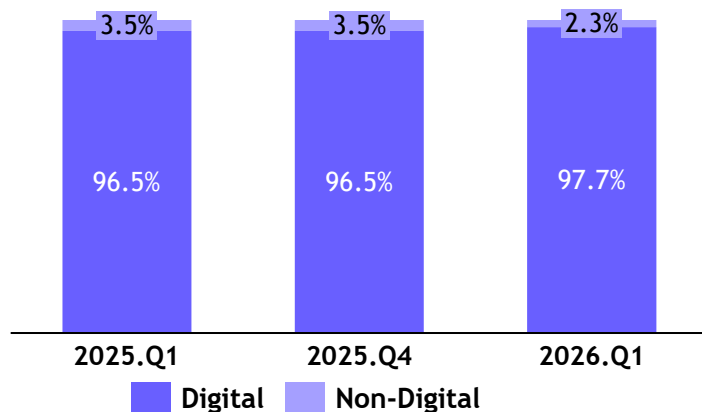
Within the assets managed by the **investment services division**, the proportion of bonds increased by 1.5 percentage points and the proportion of investment fund shares rose by 0.6 percentage points since the beginning of the year. The number of securities accounts increased by 8.1%.

Breakdown of investment services within the portfolio

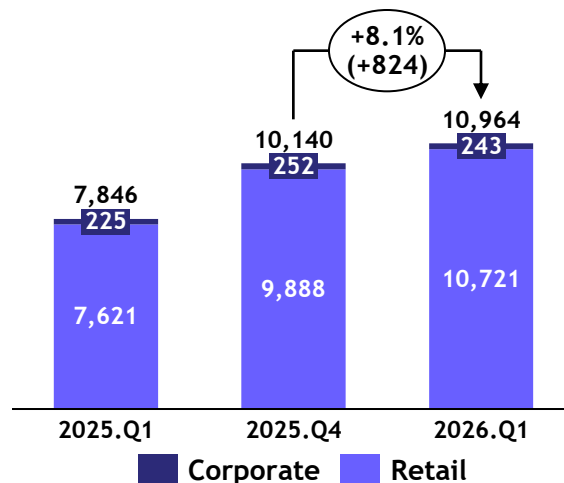


- As of the end of Q1 2026, Gránit Bank manages nearly 11,000 securities accounts.
- In the investment services segment, as of March 31, 2026, clients' securities portfolios are linked to 10,964 securities accounts.
- The share of investment funds increased by 0.6 percentage points, and the share of bonds increased by 1.5 percentage points during the first quarter of this year.
- Equities account for two-thirds of the assets managed here, while bonds—primarily government securities—make up 28% of the portfolio.
- Nearly all securities account openings take place via digital channels.
- In terms of volume, 97.7% of orders in Q1 2026 were received via digital channels, while 56.6% of the total value of orders was processed through these channels.

Pocket Savings function

- Gránit Bank has introduced a new savings product, the Gránit Pocket. Any retail customer can set up a Pocket account in just a few clicks using the Gránit app. You can assign a goal to the Pocket and customize it with eye-catching icons. You can specify the amount needed to reach your goal, and—uniquely among Hungarian banks—you can start saving not only in forint but also in foreign currencies (EUR, USD, RON). In addition to Hungarian customers, the Pocket is also available in Romania



Revamping the selfie account opening process

- The Bank has significantly revamped its self-service account opening process. In addition to technological innovations (new solutions for document verification and identity verification), the process has become even simpler and faster. You can now open an account in the Gránit app in as little as 1.5 to 2 minutes. Thanks to the new technologies, back-end processes have also been significantly reduced. Building on the new selfie-based process, the Bank has introduced four completely new account packages for retail customers:
 1. The Hello package offers free account maintenance with no strings attached and a free virtual card, and transfers are also free up to 50,000 HUF per month.
 2. The Plus package offers free account maintenance and a bank card provided the account is credited with at least 150,000 HUF per month, as well as foreign exchange at the mid-market rate up to 650,000 HUF, and a free virtual euro card and euro account.
 3. The Premium package offers unlimited transfers and a Platinum card with discounted fees for a low monthly fee, allows currency exchange at the mid-market rate up to 1 million HUF, and includes numerous free extra features.
 4. With the Prestige account package, transfers are unlimited and free, the monthly limit for currency exchange at the mid-market rate is 1.5 million forints, and it provides a free Platinum card with premium benefits.

Single-use debit card

- The one-time use card, which makes online shopping safer, is now available not only to Hungarian customers but also to Romanian customers. The one-time use card is completely free for all customers and can be created in the Gránit app with just a few clicks; moreover, it can be issued in foreign currency (EUR, USD, RON) or linked to a credit card. The card can be used for a single purchase and expires immediately afterward, making it impossible to commit fraud with the card details.

Mortgage Lending Processes

- The Bank has further improved both the sales and back-office processes for mortgage loans. A new calculator and lead management system was developed for mortgage loan sales representatives, and the processing of loan applications was further streamlined. These improvements contributed to the Bank recording significant sales growth in the mortgage loan market—particularly in the Otthon Start loan segment.



Gránit Guru

- The Gránit Guru chatbot, powered by generative and agent-based AI, is now available on the bank's homepage, and its capabilities are constantly expanding. In addition to loans, it can now answer customers' questions about savings, accounts, cybersecurity, electronic channels, and credit cards 24 hours a day, and it can also perform loan calculations.

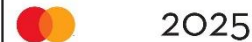

The Gránit Banking Group closed the first quarter of 2026 with a positive net profit, dynamic growth, excellent cost efficiency, a high-quality portfolio, and cutting-edge innovations

✓ Strong, dynamic business growth

- Looking at the past quarter, the Banking Group further expanded its business activities. Over the past three months, its net loan portfolio grew by 3.8%, while customer deposits increased by 11.4% compared to the end of the previous year. The consolidated value of assets managed by the Bank Group stood at HUF 4,082 billion at the end of March, an increase of 5.2% compared to the end of the previous year. The average annual equity balance increased by 2.1% to HUF 165.58 billion in Q1 2026, which enabled further growth in the loan portfolio.

✓ Excellent asset quality

- The non-performing loan (NPL) ratio stands at 0.48%, down 0.11 percentage points from the end of the previous quarter.

✓ Exceptional Cost-efficiency

- A group-level cost-to-total-assets ratio of 1.5%, which is 0.2 percentage points lower than at the end of 2025. The cost-to-income ratio (CIR%) stood at 50.8% at the end of March 2026, which is higher than Gránit Bank's standalone figure, primarily due to the differing business models of the group members.

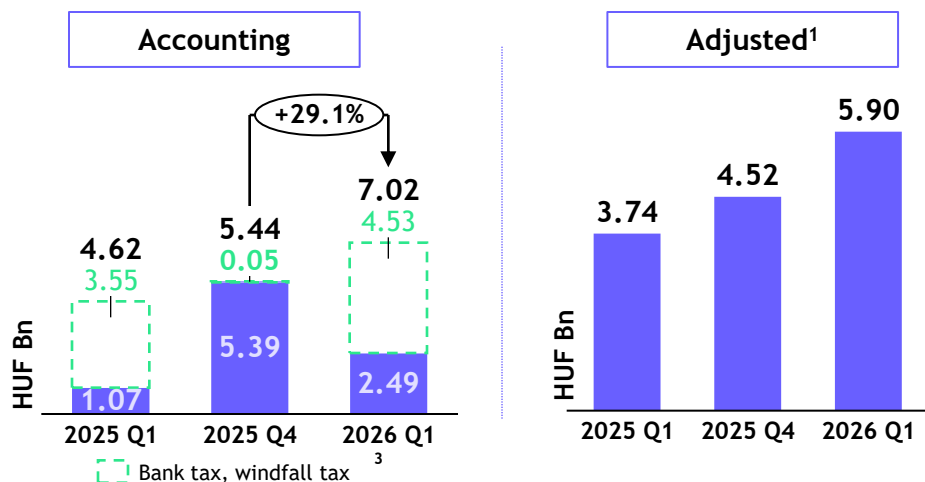
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✓ Strong Capital position and Liquidity

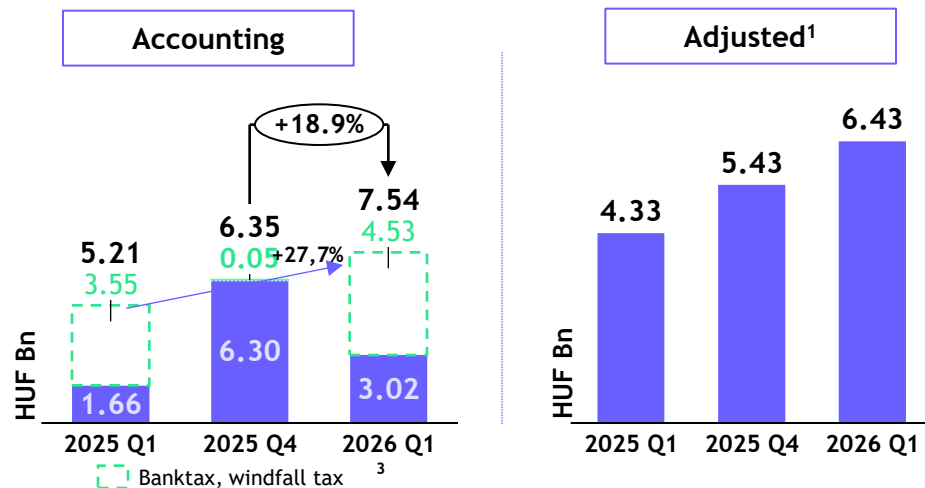
- Both the Common Equity Tier 1 (CET1) ratio and the total capital adequacy ratio stood at 18.8% at the end of the first quarter. The net LDR was 59.6% (market average: 85.8%).
- The group-level liquidity coverage ratio (LCR%) was 165.6% at the end of the first quarter of 2026, and the net stable funding ratio (NSFR%) was 163.1%.

The **Gránit Bank Group's consolidated** net income at the end of the first quarter was HUF 2.5 billion, which amounts to HUF 5.9 billion after prorating the lump-sum special taxes. Net interest and commission income, which reflects the results of business operations, increased by 3.4 percentage points over the three-month period after deducting the transaction levy.

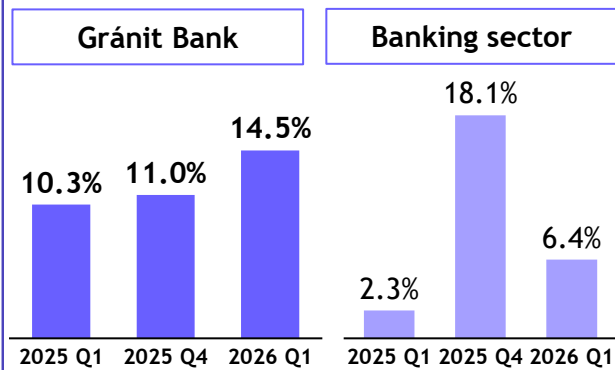
Profit after tax



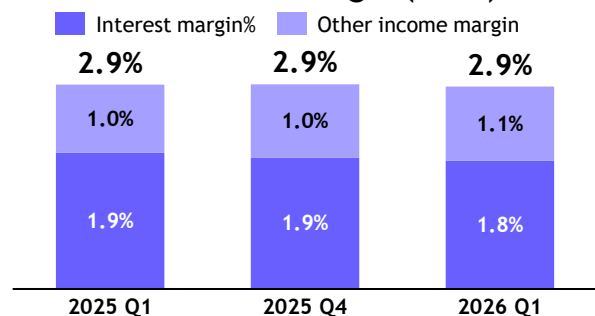
Pre-tax profit

Net income margin (NIR%)

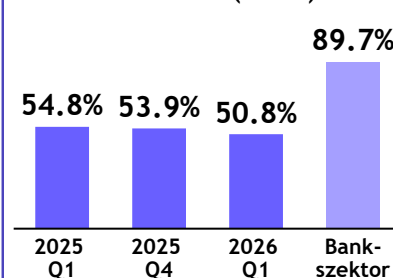


- The return on equity after taxes was 14.5%, which is 3.4 percentage points higher than the previous quarter's figure, driven by growth in operating income (interest income +1.8%; commission income +5.1%).
- The net operating margin in Q1 2026 was unchanged from the previous quarter and the same as a year earlier.
- The operating expense-to-revenue ratio and the operating expense-to-total assets ratio also improved compared to both the previous quarter and the same quarter a year earlier.

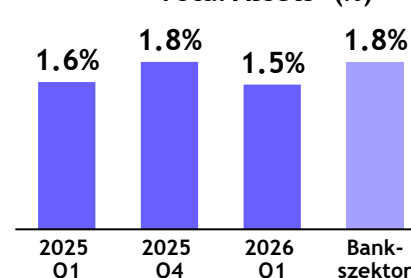

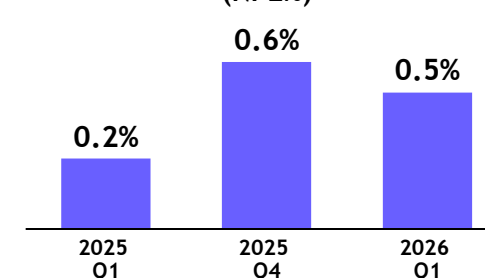
Operating costs / Income (CIR %)



Operating costs / Total Assets² (%)



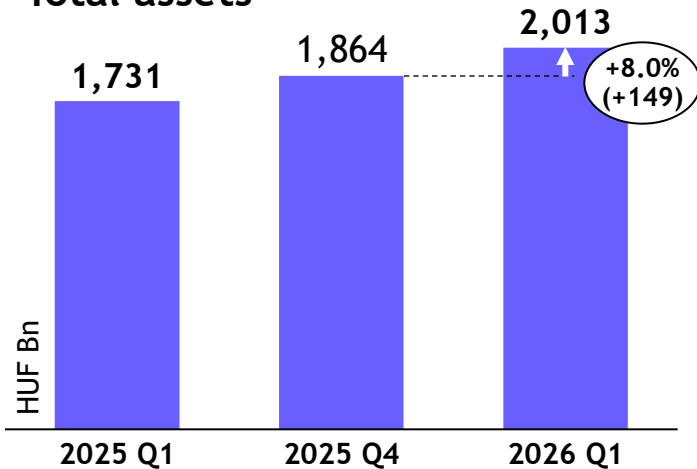
Non-performing loans (NPL%)

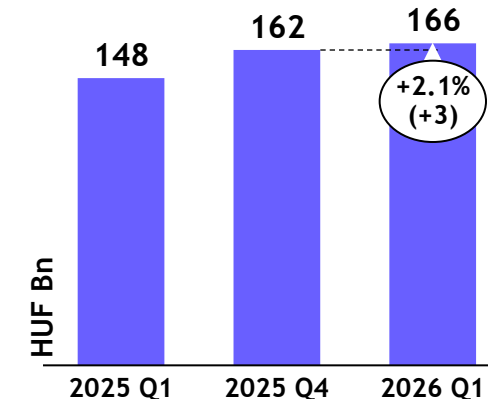
The **Gránit Bank Group's total assets** amounted to HUF 2,013 billion, an 8% growth compared to the previous quarter; equity rose by 0.7% (with a quarterly average of 2.1%), and assets under management grew by 5.2% since the start of the year.

Total assets

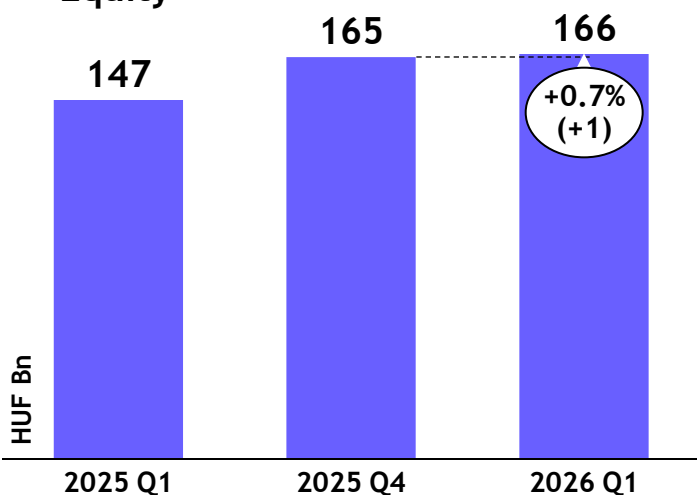


- Consolidated total assets increased by 8.0% in the past quarter. The growth was driven by an 11.4% increase in customer deposits.
- The loan portfolio grew by 3.8% during the first quarter.
- Equity increased by 12.8% compared to the same period last year. The quarterly average balance grew by 12.1% over the course of a year, while it increased by 2.1% compared to the previous quarter.
- Assets under management grew by 5.2% in the first three months of this year.

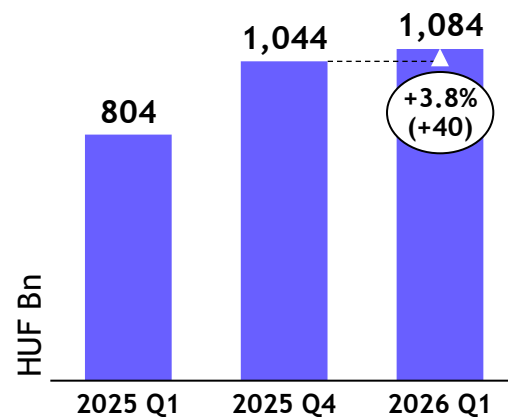
Average equity



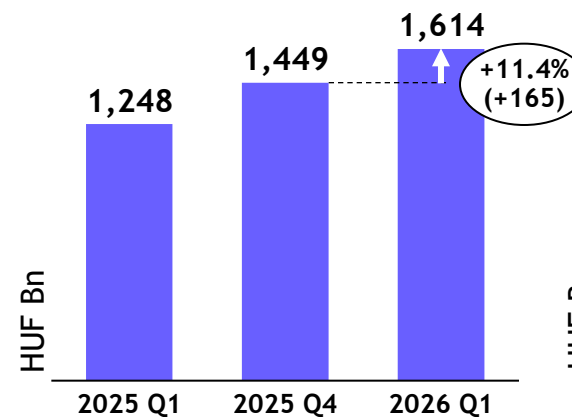

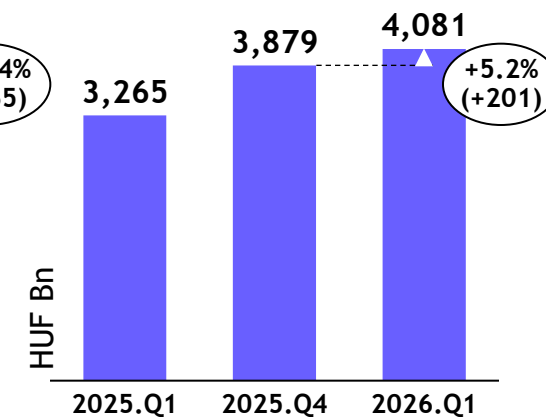
Net Loan portfolio



Deposits



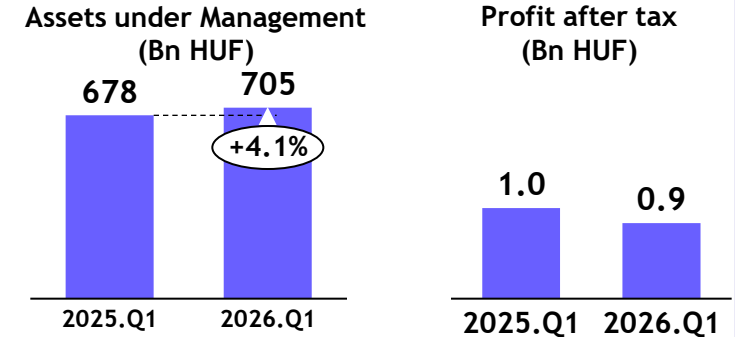
Assets Under Management

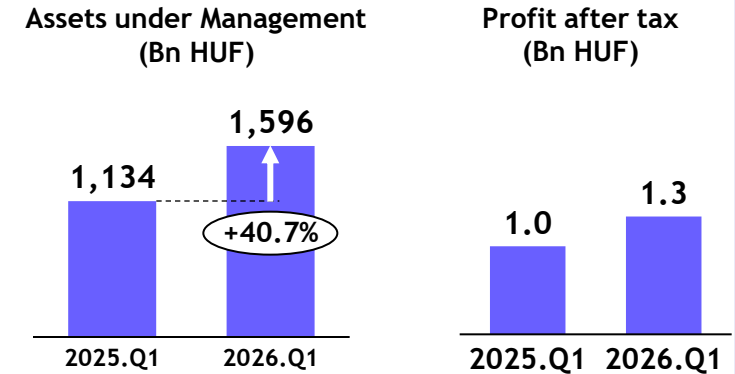
Equilor

- In the first quarter of 2026, the two companies' combined net income after taxes decreased by 16.7% compared to the first quarter of 2025. The two companies' combined return on equity was 111.9%, which is 20.1% lower than the figure from a year earlier.
- Assets under management by Equilor Investment Ltd. stood at HUF 705.4 billion at the end of March 2026, which is 4.1% higher than in the same period of the previous year, thanks to the activity of existing and new clients.
- Based on spot trading on the Budapest Stock Exchange, Equilor maintained its position compared to the same period last year.



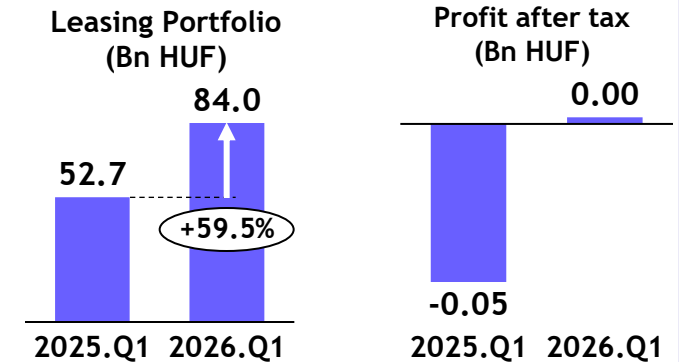
Gránit Asset Management

- Gránit Fund Management's net profit after tax stood at 1.3 billion HUF at the end of Q1 2026, which was 34% higher than the performance for the same period of the previous year.
- The annualized return on equity rose by 29.9 percentage points to 133.8% over the past year.
- Assets under management reached HUF 1.596 billion at the end of Q1 2026, representing a 41% increase compared to the same period of the previous year.
- The Manager's funds are available via the Gránit Bank mobile app, which also offers savings products combined with deposits.
- In December 2025, Gránit Fund Management won the asset management tender for the MBH Gondoskodás Health and Mutual Aid Fund and the MBH Gondoskodás Pension Fund, while Gránit Bank Nyrt. won the tender for account management for the Funds. Asset management activities commenced on January 1, 2026.
- By the end of the first quarter of 2026, the Gránit Harmónia Mixed Fund had surpassed the 125 billion forint mark.



Gránit Leasing

- Gránit Lízing's net profit for Q1 2026 was HUF 1.9 million, which is HUF 47.2 million higher than the result for the same period last year.
- The leasing portfolio reached HUF 84 billion by the end of March 2026, representing a 2.3% increase compared to the end of the previous year and significantly outperforming the leasing market, which saw a 3% decline. According to statistics from the Leasing Association, Gránit Lízing ranked ninth in both new placements and portfolio size in Q1 2026.
- In 2026, the Company further strengthened its business activities in the passenger vehicle and agricultural financing sectors and played an active role in subsidized financing schemes, such as the Széchenyi Card Program and the EXIM Sándor Demjén Program.



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
