Resolution of the Magyar Nemzeti Bank on the prohibition of unlawful conduct and imposition of a market surveillance fine against the Issuer

The Magyar Nemzeti Bank has issued a resolution under No. H-PJ-III-B-2/2025 (published on 16 January 2025) prohibiting unlawful conduct and imposing a market surveillance fine against PannErgy Nyilvánosan Működő Részvénytársaság (registered office: H-1112 Budapest, Boldizsár utca 2; company registration number: 01-10-041618) for violating the legal provisions on the prohibition of market manipulation.

In the course of the market surveillance procedure carried out to investigate the activities of PannErgy Nyilvánosan Működő Részvénytársaság (registered office: H-1112 Budapest, Boldizsár utca 2; company registration number: 01-10-041618) (hereinafter: Client1) and (...) (hereinafter: Client2), the Magyar Nemzeti Bank (registered office: H-1013 Budapest, Krisztina körút 55; site: H-1122 Budapest, Krisztina körút 6) (hereinafter: MNB) has issued the following resolution with respect to the Issuer:

I.

The MNB prohibits Client1 from repeatedly violating the legal provisions on the prohibition of market manipulation provided for in the EU Market Abuse Regulation.

II.

The MNB imposes on Client1 a market surveillance fine of HUF 10,000,000, i.e. ten million Hungarian forints, for violating the legal provisions on the prohibition of market manipulation.
